

Tyner said she was inspired by the graphic images of death involving **Emmett Till**, which became a catalyst for the civil rights movement. The graphic image of **Kim Phuc**, hit by napalm, showed the horrors of the Vietnam War. Other images from Syria and Somalia have shown children as victims. Tyner argues that the images of children in the crosshairs of violence could stir the public to action when readers and viewers become numb to graphic images involving adults.

MyLastShot.org organizer Kaylee Tyner, a Columbine High School student, was not born when the shooting occurred. But she says that if students placed a small sticker on their IDs stating, "In the event that I die from gun violence, please publicize the photo of my death," it would force the public to pay attention to the lives lost. "No other generation has had to think about where they'd hide at a high school dance, or when they last texted their mom when the fire alarm goes off," she said. "For us, this is about empowerment. Sure, we're all taking a pledge that lets others know our wishes to have our photos publicized, but the message is bigger even than the outcome. It's saying that kids across the nation, young enough to not be alive during the first high school shooting in U.S. history think the only way to end gun violence is to release the photos of our bodies."
